Engine	5-6 HP Petrol OHV Engine with oil alert
Nozzle	1x20m High pressure hose is provided on a galvanized hose reel. Pistol type spray gun can be adjusted from fog spray to solid stream.
General	Pump and engine unit mounted on anti-vibration rubbers.
