T1.1 Tender Notice and Invitation to Tender

Ubuntu Local Municipality invites tenders for the Upgrading of Pipelines between Moonlight and Hostel Reservoirs

Only CSD Registered Tenderers with a CIDB grading of 4CE or HIGHER are eligible to submit tenders.

Preference will be given to bidders who advance the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act No 5 of 2000.

Please Note:

- Preference will be given to construction companies who are owned by Women, Youth and Persons with Disabilities.
- Functionality and 80/20 principle evaluation criteria will apply. Based on functionality a bidder should score 70 or more on the following criteria to be further evaluated:

Functionality	Criteria	Weight
1.	Experience of Tenderer	30%
2.	Project Staff Experience	50%
3.	Plant and Equipment	15%
4.	Woman and Youth Owned	5%
TOTAL		100%

- Documents to be submitted with the tender document: An original valid Tax Clearance Certificate or certified copy inclusive of verification PIN, CIDB registration certificate, Copy of CSD Registration summary report, B-BBEE Status Level Certificates or certified copies thereof. Exempted Micro Enterprises must in terms of B-BBEE Act or Verification Agency accredited by SANAS or Registered Auditor.
- Audited financial statements for the last three years also to be submitted with the tender document.
- The requirements of the Preferential Procurement Regulation, 2017 (Government Gazette No. 10684) shall also apply, together with all other requirements as set out in the Tender Data.
- Failure to comply with above requirements will result in automatic disqualification if the bidder.
- Ubuntu Local Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to tender and/or re-advertise or to reject any tender or to accept a part of it. Ubuntu Local Municipality does not bind itself to accepting the lowest tender or award a contract to the bidder scoring the highest number of points.
- Tenders will be opened directly after closing. Due to a two-stage evaluation process tender prices will **NOT** be read out.
